This week's question: When and why did the Church stop referring to the Third Person of the Trinity as the Holy Ghost and begin using Holy Spirit?

Answer to last week's question: Indulgences were mentioned in a homily last week. I thought the Church did away with indulgences after Vatican II? What is the current understanding of indulgences? There are many misconceptions about indulgences, and they have received some "bad press" in the recent past, but they are certainly still part of our Catholic faith. An **indulgence**, in Roman Catholic theology, is related to the dogma of Purgatory, and is the full or partial remission of temporal punishment (time in Purgatory) due for sins which have already been forgiven. There is a common misconception that indulgences forgive sins, however, they only relieve the punishment due because of the sins, and a person is still required to have their sins absolved by a priest to receive salvation.

To gain any indulgence you must be a Catholic in a state of grace. The indulgence is granted by the Church after the sinner has confessed and received absolution. The belief is that indulgences draw on the storehouse of merit acquired by Jesus' sacrifice and the virtues and penances of the saints. They are granted for specific good works and prayers. An indulgence may be plenary (full remission of temporal punishment), or partial, remitting only part of the temporal punishment. To gain a partial indulgence, you must perform with a contrite heart the act to which the indulgence is attached. To gain a plenary indulgence you must perform the act with a contrite heart, plus you must go to confession (one confession may suffice for several plenary indulgences), receive Holy Communion, and pray for the pope's intentions. (An Our Father and a Hail Mary said for the pope's intentions are sufficient, although you are free to substitute other prayers of your own choice.) The final condition is that you must be **free from all attachment to sin, including venial sin**. Because of the extreme difficulty in meeting the final condition, plenary indulgences are more difficult to obtain. If you attempt to receive a plenary indulgence, but are unable to meet the last condition, a partial indulgence is received instead. Indulgences may be applied to oneself or to any soul in Purgatory.

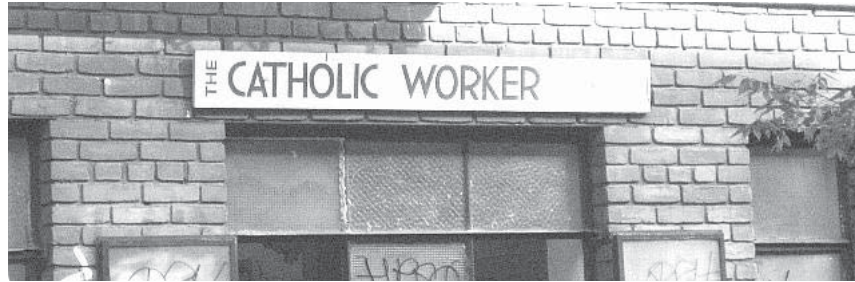
