From the Pastor's Desk

Weekday Mass

While celebrating weekday Mass lately when leaving the pulpit after the homily I have noticed an increase in the number of parishioners sitting in the dark on the south side of the Church.

Because of an extension built in the early 1950's, we have an unusual Church with pews on both sides of the sanctuary. On weekdays and for weddings or funerals, when the congregation is smaller than on Sunday, all should gather in the original part of the Church on the north side of the sanctuary. The priest's chair faces the north side, the readings are proclaimed facing the north side and we only have communion stations on the north side of the sanctuary.

I strongly encourage all who come to weekday Mass to sit on the north side of the sanctuary.

I think most of those who are sitting on the south side of the sanctuary have arrived a little late for Mass. If you are late and do not want to walk past the sanctuary to your place, please use one of the side entrances to the Church or walk around to the Northern Blvd. entrance.

When we gather to celebrate Mass we are to form a "community of prayer". We are not individuals at prayer. Part of forming a "community of prayer" is that we are physically close to each other and that we are all in the priest's view when he says "The Lord be with you."

Adult Faith Formation

Do You Know?

This week's question: I have not been to confession for awhile. Can I still receive Communion at Mass?

Answer to last week's question: How late can I come to Mass and have it still "count?" If you are asking this question you are looking at the issue from a purely legalistic point of view. Before Vatican II, some moral theology manuals placed arrival before the offertory as the dividing line for deciding whether one fulfilled the Sunday obligation of assistance at Mass. However, the celebration of the Mass is a cohesive whole. One should be present from the very beginning. Arriving on time is not just a question of obligation but of love and respect for Our Lord who has gathered us together to share his gifts and who has some grace to communicate to us in each part of the Mass. It is also a sign of respect for the community with whom we worship and who deserves our presence and the contribution of our prayers in each moment. Thus people who arrive late to Mass have to honestly ask themselves, "Why?" The same can be asked by those who leave early.
